Mr. Wittek led the discussion for committee feedback on the draft 5-Year Strategic Plan presented to the County Board.

Mr. Gerol spoke to defects in Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats (S.W.O.T.) analysis, and the minimal benefit of a drug court in Ozaukee County.

Sheriff Johnson spoke to reentry programs for people leaving the jail with addictions, and the need to include in the strategic plan maintaining the same service level of efficiencies in Public Safety.

Consensus on evaluating the need for a drug court, same level of support for Public Safety as is given to facilities, and a plan for secure detention for juveniles pre adjudication.

Discussion on the need for on demand ridership, innovative transportation solutions, and supporting employee recruitment and retention.
