WE WILL NOT ACCEPT:

1. **LATEX PAINTS AND STAINS**
2. Ammunition
3. Compressed gas cylinders
4. Explosives and ordnance, including detonators and blasting caps
5. High-pressure cylinders or tanks; propane
6. Infectious or biological wastes or needles (sharps)
7. Motor oil (used)
8. Radioactive chemicals and devices (e.g., smoke alarms)

**We WILL accept *most* unlabeled
(origin unknown) chemicals.**

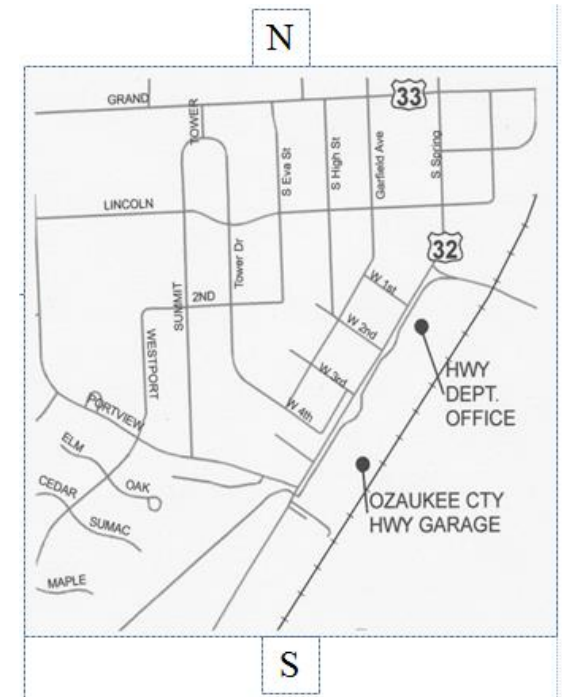
Small Businesses (VSQGs)

City of Port Washington residents may take household hazardous waste to the Veolia location at 1275 Mineral Springs Drive any Monday . . . free of charge. **BUT . . . used tires WILL be accepted from City of Port Washington residents at the Clean Sweep event on June 10.**
