TOWN BOARD MINUTES
June 1, 2009

Call to Order: A meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Belgium was held on Monday, June 1, 2009, in the Town Hall at 814 Main Street, Belgium. Chairman Francis Kleckner called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. **Also Present:** Bill Janeshek, Janet Coeur, Tom Winker, Ron Swihart, Dennis Dimmer, Richie Depies, Charlie Parks, Clem Gottsacker (Village of Belgium Trustee), Kevin Kowalkowski (Village of Belgium President), John Riordan and Ginger Murphy.

Minutes: Motion by Winker, second by Janeshek, to approve the minutes of the last meeting as previously distributed; motion carried.

Building Permits:

Peter Demopolous, 2254 Jay Rd., has made modifications without building permits. The Zoning Administrator was instructed to contact Mr. Demopolous.

Transfer Site: Tom Winker reported that we should see a \$135 credit on the Veolia invoice for an erroneous pick up of a bin half full.

Temporary Liquor License OWLT: Motion by Kleckner, second by Winker, to approve the temporary liquor license for August 16, 2009, at the Forest Beach Migratory Preserve, motion carried.

Liquor Licenses: Motion by Janeshek, second by Winker, to approve the Class B Combination Liquor Licenses for Lake Church Inn and Cedar Beach Inn and temporary picnic licenses for St. Marys Lake Church and Holy Rosary Parishes, motion carried.

Squires Sign on Corner of LL and Cty Rd P: This Squires Country Club sign is nonconforming and is required to conform to the Zoning Ordinance upon its discontinued use. The Clerk sent a letter on March 31, 2009, to Bruce Bloemer (previous Squires owner) and the Ozaukee Washington Land Trust (current landowner) requesting that the sign be removed within 60 days. No action was taken by either party. Further investigation will be taken by the Clerk to determine who is responsible for the sign.

Other Signs: The Clerk was instructed to contact Mueller Construction and Bill Large Masonry to remove signs from Cedar Beach Rd and Cty Rd D respectively. Temporary signs are allowed on the premise where the work is in progress and must be removed upon completion.

Citizen Input: The recently elected Village of Belgium President, Kevin Kowalkowski, introduced himself and asked for opinion of the Cedar Grove-Belgium School District's referendum to build a school in Cedar Grove as opposed to Belgium.

Monthly invoices: Invoices were audited and ordered paid.
