TOWN BOARD MINUTES  
September 8, 2009

**Call to Order:** A meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Belgium was held on Tuesday, September 8, 2009, in the Town Hall at 814 Main Street, Belgium. Chairman Francis Kleckner called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**Also Present:** Bill Janeshek, Janet Coeur, Charlie Parks, Carol Pomeday of the Ozaukee Press, Ginger Murphy, and 13 interested persons. Tom Winker not present.

**Minutes:** Motion by Janeshek, second by Kleckner, to approve the minutes of the last meeting as previously distributed; motion carried.

**Road Update:** Paving is complete for 2009. Paving aid will appear on next month's invoice.

**Transfer Site Update:** Citizen request to extend dump hours through daylight savings time. It was decided to keep the dates that have already been decided and published.

**Noise complaint at Sharon Cutwell:** Tom Winker not present to report progress. This will appear on next month's agenda.

**Lake Church Septic Issues:** Septic systems of four residents have wastewater running into the ditch. The County has requested new septic systems be installed by November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009.

**Signage of Sauk Trail:** Andrew Krueger representing Harrington Beach State Park believes the town should maintain the 'no parking' and 'no turn' signs on Sauk Trail. Bill Janeshek stated that Sauk Trail is a public right of way and doesn't believe the Park should be authorized to issue citations on Sauk Trail Road. The Clerk will search records to find if an ordinance was ever adopted restricting parking and making turns on Sauk Trail Rd. This will appear on next month's agenda.

**Electric Vehicle Ordinance request for Harrington Beach State Park:** Waiting on recommendation by the WI Towns Association.

**Noxious Weed Ordinance:** Motion by Janeshek, second by Kleckner to adopt Ordinance 2009-02, motion carried. Bill Janeshek volunteered to be weed commission.

**Liquor License Permit:** Motion to approve Class B Liquor License for PCLT Hospitality, second by Kleckner, motion carried.

**Citizen Input:**

Belgium Chamber of Commerce asking for \$750 to place signs along bike trail locating area businesses. The signs will identify Lake Church Inn, Lakeview Buffalo Farm, Cedar Beach Inn, and the Forest Beach Migratory Preserve. This will appear on next month's agenda.

Two representatives spoke in support of maintaining library reimbursement at 85% for those libraries that provide more than 3% of their total material lending to non-librarians and asked the Town to formally show support in the form of a letter or resolution. The Ozaukee County Admin Committee is proposing no increase in 2010. (The Town of Belgium paid \$72,316 for library services in 2009.) This will appear on next month's agenda.

**Monthly invoices:** Invoices were audited and ordered paid.
