TOWN BOARD MINUTES  
June 6, 2011

**Call to Order:** Chairman Tom Winker called the Town Board meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**Minutes:** Motion by Kleckner, second by Janeshek, to approve the minutes of the May 2, 2011, meeting; motion carried unanimously.

**Painting of Town Hall:** Estimates from RS All-Terior Painting, LLC, and Dave Schueller Painting of Belgium, Inc. were presented. As requested, the estimate from Schueller is only for the front of the building. Tom Winker will ask Mr. Schueller to give an estimate for the entire building as well. The estimate from RS All-Terior includes both options. Jeff Coeur brought up the fact that there are new lead law restrictions when painting old buildings and the contractors will have to comply with these new laws. Ron Swihart mentioned he might be interested in doing the painting.
