TOWN BOARD MINUTES  
January 3, 2012

**Call to Order:** Chairman Tom Winker called Town Board meeting to order at 8:10 p.m.

**Also Present:** Supervisors Francis Kleckner and Bill Janeshek, Treasurer Janet Coeur, and Clerk Ginger Murphy. Charlie Parks, John Riordan, Dennis Dimmer, Rick Pieper, Carol Pomeday of the Ozaukee Press. Quorum established.

**Minutes:** Motion by Kleckner to approve the minutes of the December 5th meeting, second by Janeshek; motion carried unanimously.

**Building Permits:** Charlie distributed summary report of building permits issued in 2011. No permits issued in December.

**Road Update:** Brushing to be done on Indian Trail road.

**OWLT Law Suite:** Tom informed that the Town has settled with Ozaukee Washington Land Trust and has been ordered to reimburse OWLT \$14,005 for property and personal property taxes paid in 2009 and 2010. The money will be paid from the current Town budget. The Clerk will work the Department of Revenue to recover taxes paid to the schools and county. This money is expected to be refunded in 2013.

**Citizen Input:** Rick Pieper, 7101 Six Mile Rd., asked the Board for assistance in getting something done to clean up the heavy sludge left on roads by a neighboring farmer. Although he understands the road will get muddy in a farming area, this occurs on many occasions. His main concern is safety, and he stated that recently his car with his family inside was sliding sideways going only 40 mph due to the sludge on the road. Rick has been unsuccessful in several attempts at making contact with his neighbor. The clerk was instructed to send a letter to Peter Demopoulus to clean up his mess. Tom stated that this is a known problem in that area, and the Town wants to be proactive before an accident occurs.

**Monthly invoices:** Invoices were audited and ordered paid.
