

**TOWN OF FREDONIA

PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 2011 PROPOSED BUDGET  
MINUTES**

A Public Hearing on the proposed 2011 budget was held on Wednesday evening, November 10, 2010, in the Town Hall. Chairman Richard Mueller called the hearing to order at 7:00 p.m.

TOWN OFFICIALS PRESENT: Chairman Mueller; Supervisors: John Blasczyk, Chris Janik, Lance Leider, James Stemper; Clerk, Janis Stemper; Deputy Clerk Dave Gorton.

This hearing was held in compliance with the Open Meeting Law in that notice was posted in at least three public places in the Town and e-mailed to THE SOUNDER, OZAUKEE PRESS, AND MILWAUKEE JOURNAL-SENTINEL. The Public Hearing notice was also published in the OZAUKEE PRESS, and was posted on the Town Web site.

In addition to Town Officials, there were eleven (11) people present.

Chairman Mueller presented an overview of the revenues and disbursements in the proposed budget and asked for any questions or comments. The 2011 Town Tax Levy proposed is \$393,572.00. This reflects a 2% increase over 2010. Clerk Stemper reviewed the tax levy and commented on the Waubeka Street Light District budget.

Judy Albert asked if money can be added for sound proofing the FGC hall as there is too much echo during elections. Item was referred to Fredonia Government Center Committee.
