

**TOWN OF FREDONIA

PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 2012 PROPOSED BUDGET
MINUTES**

A Public Hearing on the proposed 2012 budget was held on Wednesday evening, November 9, 2011, in the Town Hall. Chairman Richard Mueller called the hearing to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:30 p.m.

TOWN OFFICIALS PRESENT: Chairman Mueller; Supervisors: John Blasczyk, Chris Janik, Mark Schubert; Clerk, Janis Stemper; Deputy Clerk Dave Gorton.

This hearing was held in compliance with the Open Meeting Law in that notice was posted in at least three public places in the Town and e-mailed to the Sounder, the Ozaukee Press, and the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel. The Public Hearing notice was also published in the Ozaukee Press and posted on the Town Web site.

In addition to Town Officials, there were fourteen (14) people present.

Chairman Mueller presented an overview of the revenues and disbursements in the proposed budget and asked for any questions or comments. The budget includes a proposed Town Tax Levy of \$394,984.00 (0.36% increase).
