TOWN CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER 4.01

4.01 APPOINTMENT. See sec. 1.03(3) of this Code.

4.02 JURISDICTION AND DUTIES. The Town Code Enforcement Officer shall have the following jurisdiction and duties:

(1) Obey all lawful, written orders of the Town Board and enforce all violations of this Code, except if such violations pertain to moving traffic violations and arrests requiring peace officer powers. A nonexclusive list of the sections of this Code under which the Town Code Enforcement Officer may issue citations as directed by the Town Board are more specifically enumerated in the Town Bond Schedule.

(2) To serve within the Town any writ, process, order or notice and execute any order, warrant or execution lawfully directed to or required by any court or official that may be executed by a town constable.

(3) Inform the District Attorney or the County Sheriff of all trespassers on public lands of which the Officer has knowledge or information.

(4) Impound cattle, horses, sheep, dogs and other animals at large in the Town and enforce the section of this Code pertaining to stray dogs.

4.03 OTHER REMEDIES. The jurisdiction and duties of the Town Code Enforcement Officer, as provided herein, shall not preclude the Town Board or any other Town officer from proceeding under any section of this Code or law or by any other enforcement method to enforce any section of this Code or any order.
