

**TOWN OF FREDONIA
NOVEMBER 8, 2007
PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 2008 PROPOSED BUDGET**

A Public Hearing on the proposed 2008 budget was held on **Thursday evening, November 8, 2007**, in the Waubeka Firehouse meeting room, W4114 River Street. Chairman Richard Mueller called the hearing to order at 7:30 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. **TOWN OFFICIALS PRESENT:** Chairman Mueller; Supervisors: Chris Janik, Lance Leider, Catherine Stern, James Stemper; Treasurer and Deputy Clerk Dave Gorton; Clerk, Janis Stemper. This hearing was held in compliance with the Open Meeting Law in that notice was posted in at least three public places in the Town and e-mailed to **THE SOUNDER, OZAUKEE PRESS, AND MILWAUKEE JOURNAL-SENTINEL**. The Public Hearing notice was also published in the **OZAUKEE PRESS**, and was posted on the Town Web site.

In addition to Town Officials, there were 32 citizens present.

Chairman Mueller presented an overview of the revenues and disbursements in the proposed budget and asked for any questions or comments. The 2008 Town Tax Levy proposed is \$333,628 which reflects a 2.7% increase over 2007. There were no questions or comments.

MOTION Cathy Stern to close the Public Hearing; second Jim Stemper; carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:44 pm.
