

TOWN OF FREDONIA
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES – 3/18/09
Comprehensive Plan: 2035

The Town of Fredonia held a Public Hearing on Wednesday, March 18, 2009, in the Town Hall, 242 Fredonia Avenue, to hear comments concerning the Town of Fredonia Comprehensive Plan: 2035.

Chairman Mueller called the hearing to order at 7:15 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

OFFICIALS PRESENT: Chairman Rich Mueller; Supervisors: Chris Janik, Lance Leider, James Stemper, Cathy Stern, Town Clerk Janis Stemper and Deputy Clerk Dave Gorton.

This hearing was held in compliance with the Open Meeting Law in that notice was posted in at least four public places in the Town and e-mailed to the Sounder, the Ozaukee Press, and the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel.
