

**TOWN OF FREDONIA
NOVEMBER 11, 2009
PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 2010 PROPOSED BUDGET**

A Public Hearing on the proposed 2010 budget was held on Wednesday evening, November 11, 2009, in the Town Hall. Chairman Richard Mueller called the hearing to order at 7:07 p.m.

TOWN OFFICIALS PRESENT: Chairman Mueller; Supervisors: Chris Janik, Lance Leider, Catherine Stern, James Stemper; Clerk, Janis Stemper, Deputy Clerk Dave Gorton.

This hearing was held in compliance with the Open Meeting Law in that notice was posted in at least three public places in the Town and e-mailed to THE SOUNDER, OZAUKEE PRESS, AND MILWAUKEE JOURNAL-SENTINEL. The Public Hearing notice was also published in the OZAUKEE PRESS, and was posted on the Town Web site.

In addition to Town Officials, there were seventeen (17) people present.

Chairman Mueller presented an overview of the revenues and disbursements in the proposed budget and asked for any questions or comments. The 2010 Town Tax Levy proposed is \$379,175.00. This reflects a 3% increase over 2009. Clerk Stemper reviewed the tax levy and commented on the Waubeka Street Light District budget.

MOTION: by Stemper to close the Public Hearing; second Stern; carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:12 p.m.
