

TOWN OF FREDONIA PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

Conditional Use Permit for Tattoo Studio

The Town of Fredonia held a Public Hearing on Wednesday, December 8, 2010, in the Town Hall, 242 Fredonia Avenue, to hear comments for or against a request by Adam Reas for a Conditional Use Permit to open a graphic design and tattoo studio.

Chairman Mueller called the hearing to order at 7:37 p.m.

OFFICIALS PRESENT: Chairman Rich Mueller; Supervisors: John Blasczyk, Chris Janik, Lance Leider, James Stemper, Town Clerk Janis Stemper and Deputy Clerk Dave Gorton.

This hearing was held in compliance with the Open Meeting Law in that notice was posted in at least three public places in the Town and e-mailed to the Sounder, Ozaukee Press, and Milwaukee Journal Sentinel. The Public Hearing Notice was also published in the Ozaukee Press, and posted on the Town web site.

Chairman Mueller read the Notice of Public Hearing:

The Town Board will hold a Public Hearing on Wednesday, December 8, 2010, at 7:30 p.m. after the first public hearing, at the Town Hall, Fredonia Government Center, 242 Fredonia Avenue, Fredonia, to discuss and hear comments, for or against, a request to issue a Conditional Use Permit for Goodguy Design LLC, Adam Reas, for a graphic design and as a licensed, professional tattooist. The studio will be at N5414 Cigrand Drive in Waubeka WI 53021, and is Zoned B-1. It was previously the barber shop in Waubeka. The property is described as follows: 506/148 North 59 Feet of Lot 4 Block 9 Fosters 2nd plat Section 28, Town 12 North, Range 21 East, of the Town of Fredonia, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin. The Town Board will act on this request following the Public Hearing. All interested parties, or their representatives will be heard.
