PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

Ordinance Discontinuing Fairway Drive (North end)

The Town of Fredonia held a Public Hearing on Wednesday, July 13, 2011, in the Town Hall, 242 Fredonia Avenue, to hear comments for or against the abandonment of the North (unpaved) end of Fairway Drive. Chairman Mueller called the hearing to order at 7:30 p.m.

OFFICIALS PRESENT: Chairman Rich Mueller; Supervisors: John Blasczyk and Mark Schubert, Town Clerk Janis Stemper and Treasurer Dave Gorton.

This hearing was held in compliance with the Open Meeting Law in that notice was posted in at least three public places in the Town and e-mailed to the Sounder, Ozaukee Press, and Milwaukee Journal Sentinel. The Public Hearing Notice was also published in the Ozaukee Press, and posted on the Town web site.

In addition to Town Officials there were 9 people present.

Chairman Mueller asked the clerk to read the Notice of Public Hearing, she read:

A Public Hearing will be held by the Town Board of the Town of Fredonia on the discontinuance of Fairway Drive beyond the existing road ending at the Hess and Strauss property line: the right of way in the SW ¼ and SE ¼ Section 16 (3 Rod Row per Town Records Book 1 Page 120 Dec. 20, 1871 and Book 1 Page 141 Jan. 16, 1875.) T.12. N., R. 21 E., Town of Fredonia, Ozaukee County WI.

The hearing will be held on **July 13, 2011 at 7:30 p.m. in the Town Hall at the Fredonia Government Center**, 242 Fredonia Avenue, Fredonia, Wisconsin.

The highway is considered discontinued because it has been abandoned as a route of vehicular travel and no Town funds have been expended on said highway in the last 10 years.

All interested persons wishing to comment on the discontinuance should appear at the hearing.

Chairman Mueller asked for any public comments. No response.

Chairman Mueller explained the ordinance and reasons for it

Chairman Mueller asked for any public comments a third time. No response.

Chairman Mueller asked for Motion to close Public Hearing. **MOTION:** to close Public Hearing by Blasczyk; second Schubert; carried.
