Chairperson Myers called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. at the Ozaukee County Justice Center, Room 240.

Chairperson Myers- meeting has been properly noticed. Dreblow, Garms. Motion approved.

Chairperson Myers advised the commission that Chief Deputy Knowles has resigned as the Traffic Safety Coordinator and would like to thank Chief Deputy Knowles for his service to the community and to the Traffic Safety Commission.

Introduction to members of the new coordinator, Lt. Cory McCormick.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Walker, discussion on TSC meeting dates of 04.25, 07.25, 10.24, 2007.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

Myers motion made to approve minutes. Kaul, Dreblow second. All aye. Minutes approved.

**COMMUNICATIONS:**

Lt. McCormick advised the commission of a new law being re-introduced on cell phone usage by teenage drivers. Also retesting of the elderly driver and making seat belt violations as a primary enforcement.

**VILLAGE OF BELGIUM-SPEED LIMIT:**

Commission received a request from the village of Belgium to have the speed limit reduced on North and South Royal Avenue/CTH LL and North and South Middle Road/CTH D.

Discussion on reduction of speed limit on Royal Avenue.

Motion made by Aargerup to reduce speed limit on Royal Avenue from 55 to 35 mph. 2600 feet north of CTH D and 4500 feet south of CTH D. Kaul second, Barb Aagerup, Lt. C. McCormick, John Holicek, Jean Clement, Trooper Simpson, Frederick Kaul, Jon Garms, aye. Dreblow, Brantner nye.

Discussion.

Motion made by Garms to extend speed limit reduction 4500 feet south of CTH D on Royal Avenue.

Holicek second, all aye. Motion passed.

Discussion on reduction of speed limit from 55 mph to 35 mph South and North Middle Road.

Motion made by Clement for reduction of speed limit on South and North Middle Road 2560 feet to 4500 north from CTH D to 35 mph from 55 mph. South of CTH D on Middle Road from 1350 feet to 2650 feet south from CTH D to 35 mph from 55 mph. Garms second.

Discussion

Vote on motion, all aye.

Motion passed.

Dreblow will place on Public Works Committee agenda for February 8, 2007.

Request by town of Cedarburg to lower speed limit to 45 mph from CTH Y west.

Discussion.

Dreblow motion to table recommendation until next meeting until speed survey and video has been completed.

McCormick second, all aye.

Commission will withhold its recommendation until a speed study has been completed.

#### MEDIAN BARRIER UPDATE:

Dreblow concerns on the installation of barriers, quality of workmanship and safety concerns.

Lt. Hansen-Wisconsin State Patrol will forward concerns to the Department of Transportation engineers.

Dreblow, Dane County Department of Transportation will also be assessing these items.

#### FATAL CRASHES:

Two fatal crashes with four fatalities.

Discussion on fatals.

#### STATE OFFICIAL'S REPORT:

Dave Brantner-DOT advises that the Town of Grafton, Cosco Store will be completed in Fall 2007.

Also rutting problem on I43 from STH 32 to South County Line investigation found no rutting on roadway.

Simpson advises that problem should be checked when raining. Brantner will have the surface rechecked.

**LOCAL OFFICAL'S REPORT:**

Dreblow advised the Urban Trail Project is moving forward. Bridge will be funded by the state. All work will be done locally. Work to begin in mid-August 2007. Completed by Spring 2008.
