**OZAUKEE COUNTY  
TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION MINUTES**

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**COMMUNICATIONS:**

Wisconsin State Patrol advised of possible speeders in the area of CTH NN at Wayne's Drive-In on Thursday nights; car show.

Mike Panosh will be leaving our Traffic Safety Commission for another area in the state. A new member will be assigned from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.

**Review of CTH C and CTH Y:**

City of Mequon's Public Safety Committee has tabled acting on the intersection.

Lt. McCormick advised that most of the crashes occur as people do stop on CTH Y, they just don't yield for traffic on CTH C.

Intersection will be redone in a year or two. Possible Ozaukee County will take over the entire intersection for maintenance.

Possible remedies:

Clean out brush, LED stop signs; however the cost would be excessive, rumble strips on CTH Y and each side of CTH C at intersection-problem with noise, 4-way stop sign.

Committee will take no action, awaiting decision by Mequon Public Safety Committee.

**QUARTERLY FATAL REPORT:**

One (1) fatal this quarter.

**STATE OFFICIAL'S REPORT:**

Construction on STH 167, STH 181 to I45-resurfacing from August 1<sup>st</sup> and completed by September 20<sup>th</sup>.

Railroad crossing on STH 167 will be completed by August 24<sup>th</sup>.

Construction to start on STH 60 from 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue to STH 181 in Village of Grafton signals at Keup Road .

Fatals for the state are lower; 200 fewer this year than at this time last year.

**LOCAL OFFICIAL'S REPORT:**

**EDUCATIONAL ARTICLE:**

Drunk driving penalty changes as of July 1<sup>st</sup>.  
5<sup>th</sup> offense is a felony. 4<sup>th</sup> offense is a felony also if within five years. Ignition interlock if blood alcohol/breath is over .15 for first offense and if child under the age of 16 in vehicle. Interlock is mandatory under these circumstances.

.08 had a lower fine amount has changed to same as .10.
