

**TOWN OF FREDONIA
NOVEMBER 12, 2008
PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 2009 PROPOSED BUDGET**

A Public Hearing on the proposed 2009 budget was held on Thursday evening, November 12, 2008, in the Town Hall. Chairman Richard Mueller called the hearing to order at 7:20 p.m. TOWN OFFICIALS PRESENT: Chairman Mueller; Supervisors: Chris Janik, Lance Leider, Catherine Stern, James Stemper; Clerk, Janis Stemper. This hearing was held in compliance with the Open Meeting Law in that notice was posted in at least three public places in the Town and e-mailed to THE SOUNDER, OZAUKEE PRESS, AND MILWAUKEE JOURNAL-SENTINEL. The Public Hearing notice was also published in the OZAUKEE PRESS, and was posted on the Town Web site.

In addition to Town Officials, there were 20 people present.

Chairman Mueller presented an overview of the revenues and disbursements in the proposed budget and asked for any questions or comments. The 2009 Town Tax Levy proposed is \$368,967.00. This reflects an 11% increase over 2008.

It was noted that there is an increase in the levy to cover debt service, the Waubeka Street Lighting District costs and the Waubeka Area Sanitary District increase in interest earned.

MOTION: by Stern to close the Public Hearing; second Stemper; carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
