PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES – 7/8/09  
Discontinuing Third Street as a Town Highway

The Town of Fredonia held a Public Hearing on Wednesday, July 8, 2009, in the Town Hall, 242 Fredonia Avenue, to hear comments concerning the discontinuance of Third Street as a Town Highway.

Chairman Mueller called the hearing to order at 7:35 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

OFFICIALS PRESENT: Chairman Rich Mueller; Supervisors: Chris Janik, Lance Leider, James Stemper, Cathy Stern, Town Clerk Janis Stemper and Deputy Clerk Dave Gorton.
