

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING



Daniel O'Neil *Agriculture*

- ◆ Conducted the Master Gardener Annual Meeting with 65 members present. The educational program on heritage roses culminated the annual meeting along with 2006 officer elections
- ◆ Taught at, and facilitated a Tri-county Dairy Modernization Conference. This session had twenty four farms participate. These farms are planning to conduct expansion and modernization projects in the coming year. The plans vary from adding low-cost milking parlors to the addition of completely new freestall and milking parlor operations.
- ◆ Coordinated the Ozaukee County 4-H Livestock Association educational program. This session had an outstanding presentation on animal health, provided by two veterinarians from the Cedar Grove Clinic. More than one hundred youth and adults participated.

- ◆ Talked with 7 individuals about financial issues, and referred six to our volunteer coaches. I met with one couple who listed several actions to take to improve their situation.

- ◆ Presented an interactive **Money, Money Everywhere** workshop to 9 4-Hers at the Tri-County conference at Washington Co. Fair Park.
- ◆ Wrote article for Ozaukee Press Transitions Supplement on "Are You a Protected Consumer?"
- ◆ Facilitated **Better Kid Care** program on Avoid Problem Behaviors-Teach Self Control for 15 child care providers. Four implemented program suggestions into their child care program, and earned an extra training credit.
- ◆ Complete work on state **Financial Literacy taskforce** to develop Personal Financial Literacy content and Performance Standards benchmarked for grades 4, 8 and 12.

- ◆ Conducted Comprehensive Planning Public Information Meetings for the Village of Thiensville, Village of Belgium and Town of Port Washington. A total of 56 people attend these meetings. - ◆ Facilitated a strategic thinking session for the Board of the Ozaukee County Tourism Council.
