

# EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING



## *Daniel O'Neil Agriculture*

- ◆ Completed agricultural participants advance registration for the September 2006 Clean Sweep Program. The actual collection will occur on September 8 and 9 at the Ozaukee County Highway department in Port Washington.
- ◆ Conducted a review meeting of the Ozaukee Master Gardeners County fair educational efforts. Both the positive feedback and suggestions for improvement were considered as the membership begins planning for the 2007 educational booth. A theme and major program content was selected so the members can begin making contacts for the items to be collected.
- ◆ Completed the final planning for the 13 week Fall 2006 Master Gardener General training Course. At this time we have 48 paid participants and the classes begin on Tuesday evening September 5th. After completing the training each participant must complete a written test and complete a minimum of 24 hours of community service to the organization.



## *Kay Buelke Schroeder 4-H & Youth Development*

- ◆ Completed preparation of 2007 4-H enrollment materials and met with general leaders and enrollment leaders to review information to be used for next year.
- ◆ Worked with volunteer co-coordinators planning the 4-H Open House on September 12th including club participation, project displays and youth and adult volunteers.
- ◆ Worked on design, printing and distribution of 4-H Open House flyers for promotion through the school districts. Paid advertisements were placed and NEW promotional "Join 4-H" lawn signs were distributed to 4-H families and can be seen throughout the county.
- ◆ Planning is taking place for fall programs including officer training; leader association reorganization and club reorganization also is taking place at this time.



## *Mary Fran Lepaska Family Living*

- ◆ Three requests for **Financial Education**-Grafton and Cedarburg couples and single Belgium mom. Volunteers will work with two families. Provided mandated Financial Education to Port Washington couple who had filed for bankruptcy. Provided mandatory pre-bankruptcy credit counseling for Cedarburg woman.
- ◆ Ozaukee County **HCE members** and family volunteered to sell over 2200 cream puffs at the county fair, with funds going towards college scholarships and the **HCE literacy project**.
- ◆ Attended **Obesity Prevention** forum and learned about the WI Nutrition and Physical Activity plan to reduce obesity and increase activity. Participated in a UW-Extension training on **Raising Healthy Eaters** and received the complete curriculum (\$500 value) to implement the series for parents of 2-5 year olds.
- ◆ Hosted with Aging Services, 14 caregivers at a Reunion picnic. Developed Caregiver bingo which reviewed for the caregivers many of the key issues shared in the 6 week series, **Powerful Tools for Caregiving**.

- ◆ Created a display on the Ozaukee County Comprehensive Planning process for the 2006 Ozaukee County Fair.
- ◆ Staffed a county fair booth and provided information on comprehensive planning, County Tourism and the Ozaukee Interurban trail.
