

# EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING



## Daniel O'Neil Agriculture

- ◆ I worked with two more farm families to complete their plans for building milking centers on their dairy operation. These projects will be constructed during the winter months.
- ◆ I taught two Pesticide Applicator Training with Allan Linnebur of Washington County UWEX. This is the final year of the training cycle, with the largest number of participants needing certification next year.
- ◆ The Master Gardeners completed the reorganization of the new 2007 Executive Board.



## Mary Fran Lepeska Family Living Educator

- ◆ Provided **financial education** to 4 different individuals who were referred by attorney, probation officer, Advocates and past program participant. Additionally, 6 individuals/couples from Mequon, Cedarburg, Saukville and Port Washington requested financial counseling and all were referred to volunteer coaches.
- ◆ Facilitated a workshop on **Obese Kids** for 20 childcare professionals with the majority indicating that they learned new information that is relevant to them and they will use in their childcare centers or homes.
- ◆ **United for Youth** began planning for annual Teen/law Enforcement Forum and a special event to raise funds for an abused woman's shelter.
- ◆ Partnering with Public Health in gathering school district wellness policies and planning presentations promoting healthy options for concession sales to booster groups and parent organizations. Goal is to help reduce obesity.
- ◆ Continued planning with Port Washington High School and Ozaukee Bank for the fall **Reality Store** event to be offered to juniors and seniors.
- ◆ Serving on the Port Washington-Saukville **Character Counts** committee and worked on developing mission statement.



## Kay Buelke Schroeder 4-H & Youth Development

- ◆ 4-H Leaders Board and the 4-H Foundation met to develop their 2007 program and financial support budgets. I worked on funding ideas for new program support.
- ◆ The 4-H **Ambassadors** taught two "Circle of Courage" **character education** Programs to thirty-nine fourth grade students at Woodview Elementary School in Grafton. I have revised four teaching programs with new activities, worked with youth during practice sessions on speaking and presentation skills, and oriented two adult volunteers who will be assisting youth with practice sessions and school visits.
- ◆ The 4-H Volunteer Leader Orientation was completed by twenty-seven first time volunteer leaders, who **teach** with two hundred fifty additional volunteers in the Ozaukee County 4-H program. I teach the required orientation on leadership responsibilities, risk management practices and youth protection.
- ◆ Thirty-seven youth and adults have reactivated the **4-H Promotion** Committee using a variety of new contact methods to invite boys, girls and families into the program.
- ◆ The Livestock Association conducted a skillathon training session for over 100 youth to share and evaluate their understanding of livestock production tools and feedstuffs. This session was designed and offered by several of the older youth members of the association based on statewide workshops they participated in during the past year.



## Paul Roback Community Development

In 2006, 1,123 people participated in UW-Extension Ozaukee Community Development Programs! Larger participatory activities include:

- ◆ First Friday Forums- 251
- ◆ Clean Sweep- 215
- ◆ Comprehensive Planning Public Information Meetings- 210
- ◆ Comprehensive Planning E-News Updates- 170
- ◆ Used-Tire Collection- 73
- ◆ Local Government Survey- 69
- ◆ Comprehensive Planning Design Workshop- 60

In addition, I regularly worked with four organizations in Ozaukee County that had 114 voluntary board members. These board members contributed over 1,400 hours of service to Ozaukee County! Finally, I developed three e-newsletters on behalf of the Ozaukee Interurban Trail Advisory Council. Each e-newsletter was sent to over 700 e-mail addresses. These addresses were acquired over the past five years through the Ozaukee Interurban Trail Web Page, which I also maintained.
