**OZAUKEE COUNTY  
TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION MINUTES**

Mark Roherty called the meeting to order at 9:57 a.m. at the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Lobby Conference Room 101.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** Mark Roherty, meeting properly noticed. Debbie Strege confirmed. Tom Grabow moved for the adoption of the Agenda. Lt. Justin Kaas second, all ayes.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS/CORRESPONDENCE/COMMUNICATIONS:** None.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF OCTOBER 23, 2019:** Lt. Justin Kaas moved to approve. Tom Grabow second, all ayes.

**ACTION ITEMS:**

**Speed Study of CTH Y in the Town of Saukville:**

Lt. Kaas discussed the speed study done on Cth Y. The speed study was performed over a 26 hour time period due to weather. The Committee decided to table this Action Item until spring when a complete speed study can be performed. Jon Edgren advised the Committee the school zone signs have been installed; however, painting of the crossways would be complete after the winter.

**Speed Study on CTH H in the Town of Fredonia:**

Jon Edgren reviewed the previous speed study done regarding Cth H in the Town of Fredonia. Jon Edgren reached out to the Town of Fredonia regarding lowering the speed limit south of Fredonia Kohler Road, and the Town had no issue regarding this action. Jon Edgren made a motion to reduce the speed limit. Tom Grabow second, all ayes.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

**QUARTERLY FATAL REPORT:**

Lt. Kaas talked about the four fatalities this quarter, three occurred in the County of Ozaukee and one occurred in the City of Mequon.

**STATE OFFICIAL'S REPORT:**

David Brantner advised the Committee a roundabout would be installed at the intersection of Sth 33 and Cth I in 2022. Flashing stop signs were installed on Cth I. Jon Edgren advised the County completed the chevron; however, markings for No Passing Zone will be done in spring.

Rick Olig discussed fatalities to date, reminded Committee members of Governor's Conference being held August 18 through August 20, 2020 and Legislature updates.

**LOCAL OFFICIAL'S REPORT:**

Mark Roherty brought Judge Ohlis' request to move the meetings to 9:00 a.m. to the Committee. Rick Olig made a motion to have Traffic Safety Commission meetings moved to start at 9:00 a.m. instead of 10:00 a.m. Jon Edgren second, all ayes.

Tom Grabow discussed the four way stop at Green Bay Road and Cth T and provided a summation of the DOT meeting regarding the freeway expansion.

Next scheduled meeting is set for Wednesday, April 22, 2020 at 9:00 a.m., at the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Lobby Conference Room 101 of the Justice Center.

Motion made to adjourn the meeting. Lt. Justin Kaas moved to adjourn the meeting, David Brantner second, all ayes.
