## What is a Stockbox!

A stockbox is a free box of food from the federal government and is given to people 60 or older and meet the financial guidelines. We call the program Stockbox because it is loaded with canned and dry goods that will help your food buying budget.

**Is there an application?** No. There is a form to sign and date. You "self declare" that you are eligible, so leave your receipts and check stubs at home. Just bring identification along to help get you signed up.

**Is this every month?** Yes, once you are enrolled you get the box every month. If you miss a month you remain enrolled. Go the following month. If you are homebound, have a family member bring a letter from a doctor or social worker and let them get you signed up. This person can also be your "proxy" and pickup your box each month.
