RESOLUTION NO. 20-6

EXTENDING THE COVID-19 STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR SIXTY (60) DAYS TO
ENSURE ELIGIBILITY OF FEDERAL AND STATE RESOURCES

WHEREAS, in December 2019, a novel strain of the coronavirus now named Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) was detected and has spread throughout many countries, including the United States; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization has declared a Public Health Emergency of International Concern; and the United States Department of Health and Human Services has declared a Public Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the existence of confirmed cases of COVID-19 within Wisconsin constitutes a condition within the County posing an imminent threat of a disaster within the meaning of Chapter 323 of the Wisconsin Statutes that could impair medical care, health protection, and other critical systems of Ozaukee County; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, protection, and welfare of persons within Ozaukee County, that reasonable and prudent steps be taken to treat those infected with COVID-19 and to prevent, limit and contain the potential community spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2020, the Ozaukee County Board ratified an Emergency Declaration issued by the County Board Chairperson on March 13, 2020, declaring a state of emergency within Ozaukee County for a period of sixty (60) days to facilitate and expedite the use of resources to protect persons from the impacts of the spread of COVID-19 while ensuring continuity of critical operations within Ozaukee County; and

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2020, the Ozaukee County Board ratified a second Emergency Declaration issued by the County Board Chairperson on March 24, 2020, declaring a state of emergency within Ozaukee County for a period of sixty (60) days to facilitate and expedite the use of resources to protect persons from the impacts of the spread of COVID-19 while ensuring continuing of critical operations within Ozaukee County and suspending specified County Policy and Procedure; and

WHEREAS, the March 13, 2020, Emergency Declaration ratified on April 1, 2020, expired on May 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the March 24, 2020, Emergency Declaration ratified on April 1, 2020, is set to expire on June 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the extension of the Ozaukee County Emergency Declaration is necessary to guarantee access to the resources of the State of Wisconsin and the Federal Government made available to Ozaukee County to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the extension of the Ozaukee County Emergency Declaration does not impede any effort to restart economic activities in Ozaukee County or the State of Wisconsin or extend the State of Wisconsin's Department of Human Services Safer at Home Orders.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Ozaukee County Board of Supervisors pursuant to sections 323.11 and 323.14(4)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes, declare that a state of

emergency continues to exist within Ozaukee County in light of the public health threat posed by COVID-19 and the state of emergency shall be extended until August 6, 2020, or until modified by further declaration or an action of the Ozaukee County Board; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, the March 24, 2020, Emergency Declaration ratified on April 1, 2020, set to expire on June 1, 2020 modifying the hours of operation of the Administration Center and allowing virtual attendance and voting at meetings of the Ozaukee County Board and the Standing Committees of the body shall be extended until August 6, 2020 or until modified by further declaration or action of the Ozaukee County Board.
