PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, in December 2019, a novel strain of the coronavirus now named Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) was detected and has spread throughout many countries, including the United States; and

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2020, Ozaukee County declared a state of emergency, pursuant to sections 323.11 and 323.14(4)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the people of Ozaukee County owe an enormous debt of gratitude to The Public Health Department under the direction of Public Health Director Kirsten Johnson for their commitment to Ozaukee County residents; and
