Procedure code: 43239. This is a procedure where a small tube with a camera on the end is inserted into the mouth and then passed down the throat to look at the esophagus, stomach, and small intestine. Other names for this procedure are Upper GI Endoscopy or EGD. This is a procedure for which small tissue samples are removed during the procedure. These biopsied samples are usually sent to a pathologist to see if there are any medical issues and the tissue goes for example to see if there is cancer in the tissue.
