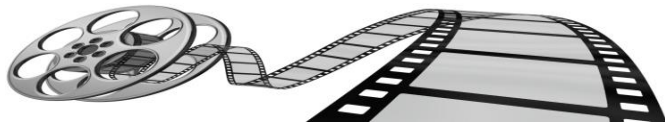
### Bubbie is Back! FOLK ART

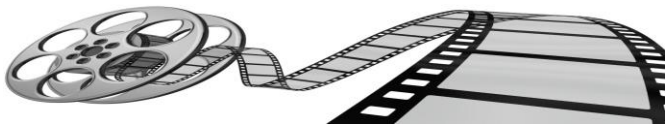
